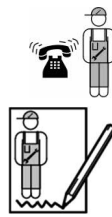

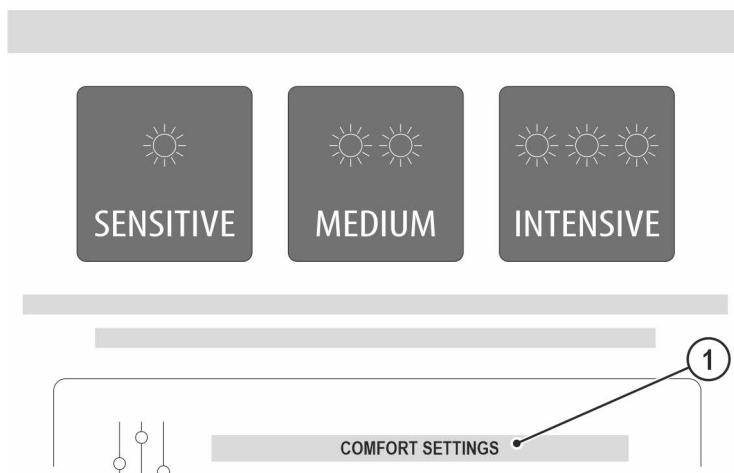

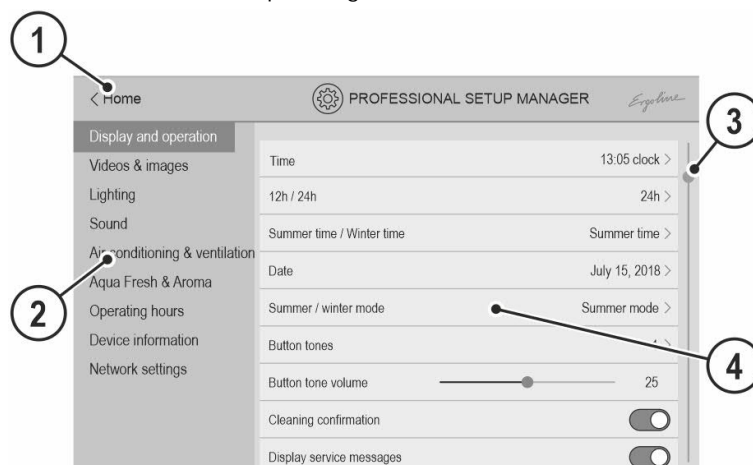

30 seconds after the last button was pressed, the device changes automatically into standby mode and the currently set values are saved.

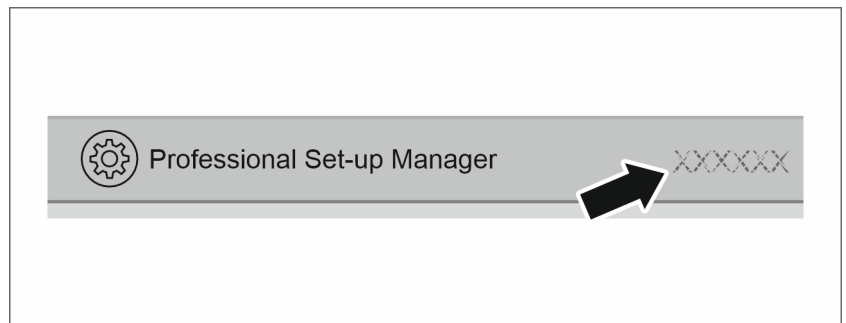
